

**In the name of God** amen I **John Corr** of **Aldborne** in ye County of Wilts Bellfounder doe make this my last will & Testament in manner following that is to say **Imprimis** I give & devise unto my Loving wife the use of ye goods in ye best Chamber halfe ye Aples y[a]t shall grow in my orchard ye whole profit of my bees for & dureing ye tearm of her naturall life **Item** I give to my daughter **Mary** ye use of **Turtons House** during ye tearm of her naturall life except my sonn **Will<sup>m</sup> Corr** & shee do live together in y[i]s case I give my Exec[utor] ye House Immediately **Item** I give unto my Granddaughter **Mary Drew** five shillings I give unto my granddaughter **Hanna Drew** tenn shillings Item I give unto my daughter **Hanna Taylor** tenn shillings Item I give unto my Grandson **John Taylor** tenn shillings I give unto my Grandsons **Willm & Zachariah Taylor** five shillings each **Item** I give unto my Daughter **Joan Woodum** forteenn pounds to be pa[i]d within twelve months after the Decease of my loving wife **Item** I give unto my Grandsonns **Will<sup>m</sup> John & Tho<sup>s</sup> Woodum** five shillings each **Item** I give to my Granddaughter **Grace Bond** tenn shillings I give unto her sonn **Dyer Bond** tenn shillings **Item** I give to my Granddaughter **Mary Corr** tenn shillings **Item** I order all those lagaceyes to be pa[i]d within twelve months after my decease except ye fiveteenn pounds w[hi]ch I order to be pa[i]d as above s[ai]d Item **I do hearby** give & bequeath unto my only sonn **William Corr** all my personall Esstate whatsoever subject as afores[ai]d & I do hereby make Constitute & appoint him ye s[ai]d William Sole & whole Exec[ut]or of this my last will & Testament & I do order & appoint my Exec[ut]or to keep & maintaine my Loving wife during ye tearme of her naturall life **In Witness whereof** I the ss[ai]d John Corr have hereunto sett my Hand & Seale & doe publish this to be my last will & Testament this nineteenth day of October in ye year of Our Lord one Thousand Seaven hundred & fourteen (1714).
