

In the name of God Amen The Nynthe day of Marche in the yeare of our Lord God according to the computation of the Church of England one Thousand sixe hundred and Fourteene and in the Twelveth yeare of the Raigne of our soveraigne Lord James by the grace of God King of England France and Ireland Defender of the faith and of Scotland the xliijth [48th] I **Edward Walrond** of **Aldeborne** in the Countie of Wiltes Esquire being sicke of body yet of perfect memorie (thanks bee given unto Almighty God therefore) am now mynded to sett an order for and touchinge all my estate, worldly goodes possessions things and causes whatsoever. And therefore doe make frame and Devise this my last Will and Testament in writinge, Conteyninge herein my last will mynde intent purpose and Testament in manner and forme following That is to say, **First and principally** I Commend my soule into the handes of Allmightie God my only maker and Creator in whome and by the merrittes of my Saviour Jesus Xpr^{ist} I doe believe to have full remission of all my synnes, And after this life ended life everlasting in heaven **And** I will my bodie to be buried in decent order and in convenient tyme after my Decease in the Ile of my parish Church of **Aldborne** aforesaid in which I doe usuallie sitt yf conveniently it may bee, otherwise in such place as it shall seeme good to my executo^r **And** I doe give and bequeathe towarde the rep^{ar}acions of the same Ile Tenn shillinges, **Item** I give and bequeathe to be Distributed by the Discretion of my Executor and my Cosine M^r **Henrie Martyn** of **Upham** to and amongst the poore people of the said parish one Annuytie or yearely sum^me of Fortie shillings yearely during the Term of Tenn years next after my Decease. **Item** I will that all and Singular such Debts and Duties I owe unto any p^{er}son or p^{er}sons shalbee well and truly paid within convenient tyme after my Decease, **Item** I give to bee distributed amongst the poore people of **Baydon** Twentie shillings, **Item** I give and bequeathe unto my Cosin **Henry Martyn** of **Upham** Esquire Twentie marks in money to be paid within one yeare next after my Decease, **and** to my Cosin **Jane Martyn** his wife Fortie Shillings to make her a Ringe, **And** to my Cosin **Edward Martyn** there sonne my godsonne I give five poundes, **And** to **Henrie Martyn** one other of their sonnes Five Poundes, **To** **Dorothie Hawkins** there Daughter Fortie shillings to make her a Ringe, **And** to **Elizabeth Brandsell** one other of Their daughters Fortie shillings to make her a Ringe **And** to every other of the Children of my said Cosins **Henry Martyn** and **Jane** I geve Five markes a peece to be delivered at their several ages of one and Twentie years or marriages which shall first happen, **Item** I give unto **Henry Martyn** my godsonne the sonne of my godson **Edward Martyn** five markes to be Delivered at his age of Tenn yeares, **Item** I geve and bequeath all my lands Tenements and hereditaments wth the appurtenances in the **Devizes** in the Countie of Wiltes unto **Edward Waldron** my Cozin and godsonne the sonne of **Thomas Walrond** sonne of my brother **William Walrond** Deceased and to the heires males of the bodie of the same **Edward** lawfullie to bee begotten, **And** for default of such yssue the remaynder thereof unto **Robert Walrond** second sonne of the said **Thomas Walrond** and to the heires males of his bodie lawfullie to bee begotten, **And** for default of such yssue the remaynder thereof unto **Thomas Walrond** the third sonne of the said **Thomas Walrond** and to the heires males of his bodie lawfully to be begotten, **And** for default of such yssue unto the said **Thomas Walrond** the father and to his heires and Assignes for ever, **Item** I geve and bequeath unto **Margery** the nowe wife of the said **Thomas Walrond** Tenn Poundes to bee made into a pair of braceletes or into a peece of plate to be used by her during her life, and my Desire is that shee shall bestowe the same at her Decease upon my goddaughter her Daughter **Dorothy Walrond**, **Item** I doe geve unto the said **Edward Walrond** sonne of the said **Thomas Walrond** sonne of my said brother **William** the som^me of Two hundred poundes of lawfull money of England to be paid at his age of one and Twentie yeares, **And** to **Robert Walrond** the second sonne of the said **Thomas Walrond** one hundred poundes in money to be paid at his age of one and Twentie yeares **And** unto **Thomas Walrond** the third sonne of the said **Thomas Walrond** Two hundred pounds in money to bee paid att his age of one and Twentie Yeares, **And** unto **Ann Walrond** and **Mary Walrond** daughters of the said **Thomas Walrond** one hundred Poundes apiece to every of them to be paid at their several ages of one and Twentie Yeares ,

Item I give unto every of her Children of my Cosin **Thomas Walrond** Deceased Five markes a peece to bee paid at their several ages of one and Twentie yeares or marriage w^hich shall first happen, **Item** I geve and bequeathe to my Cosin **W^{illia}m Keate** One hundred poundes to bee paid unto him by Twentie Poundes yearly during the five years next after my Decease, **Item** I give unto my godsonne the sonne of the same **Will^{ia}m Keate** five Markes to be delivered at his age of Tenn Yeares, **Item** I give unto my Cosine **Anne Pearse** Twentie shillings to make her a Ringe, and unto her daughter w^hich is my goddaughter Five markes to bee Delivered at her age of Tenn yeares, **Item** I give to my Cosin **Elizabeth Hopkins** Twentie shillings to make her a Ringe, **Item** I give to **Thomas Coleman** my servant Twentie shillings, **To** every of my men servantes dwellinge and lodginge in my house at the tyme of my decease Twentie shillings a peece, **Item** I geve to **Frances Webb** my servant Five marks, to **Alice Neale** my servant five markes and to everie other of my maide servantes to be dwelling with mee at the time of my Decease Tenn Shillings, **Item** I give to bee distributed amongst the poore people of **Wotton Bassett** Twentie shillings, **And** I Doe make, ordaine, constitute and appoint my said Cosin **Thomas Walrond** sonne of my said Deceased brother **William Walrond** to bee the sole, onely and whole Executor of this my last will and Testament, **And** I Doe geve and bequeathe unto the same **Thomas Walrond** all and singular my goods and Chattles moveable and unmoveable whatsoever herein not given nor bequeathed my debts and legacies beeinge paide and funeralls Discharged, **And** I Doe hartily desire and Appoint my speciall freinds the worshipfull M^r **Henry Marten** doctor of the Civill lawe, my saide Cosin M^r **Henry Marten** of **Upham** and M^r **Henry Smith** of **Baydon** to be the Overseers of this my Will and Testament prayeing them to be aydinge and assistinge to my said Executor in the p^erformance of this my will with their good advise and Counsell in what they may, **And** in remembrance of my good will towards them and in part of requitall of their loves towards mee and of their paines herein to bee taken. I give unto the said M^r Doctor **Martyn** Tenn Angells, **to** my said Cosin **Martyn** of **Upham** Sixe Angells, and to the said **Henrie Smith** four Angells, **And** I doe hereby Revoke, repeale, Countermand and pronounce to be voide all former wills and Testaments whatsoever heretofore made or pronounced by mee by worde writing or otherwise, **And** I doe affirme acknowledge and Declare this present writing to be and to Contayne my verie true last will and Testament. The *Testators marke,* **witnesses** to the signinge sealinge and pronouncing hereof by the said **Edward Walrond** the Testator, *Henrie Smith Thomas Bennett* notary publick 1614 *Henry Ewens Thomas Flower*. **A ?note?** of such legacies as my Unckle M^r **Edward Walrond** gave after the makinge of his Will, **Imprimis** unto M^r **John Webb** vicar of **Alborne** to make a him a gowne v^{li} [£5]. **Item** unto his sonne **John Webb** my godsonne to be paid at x [10] years age iij^j vj^s viij^d [£3 6s 8d], **Item** unto **Dorothy Walrond** my goddaughter v^{li} [£5], **Item** unto my sister **Ann Pearse** vj^{li} xij^s iij^j d [£6 13s 4d], **Item** unto my Cosin **Katherine** x^{li} [£5], **Item** unto **Thomas Hill** xv^s [15s]. **Item** unto my Cossen **Edward Goddard** sonne of my Cosen **John Goddard** to make him a Ringe xx^s [20s]. **Item** unto my goddaughter daughter of my Cosin **Richard Bossen** a peece of plate in valewe xl^s [60s] to bee delivered at her age of xij [12] yeares. **Item** unto my Cossen **Martyn** wife of M^r Doctor **Martyn** to make her a Ringe xls [40s]
