**Imprimis** I give unto my daughter **Ann Collens** one hundred pounds And to be paid her within one yeare & halfe next after my decease

**Item** I give unto my daughter **Elizabeth Collens** fourscore pounds and to be paid her within two yeares & half next after my decease, **Item** I give unto my daughter **Susanna Neale** one shilling & to be paid her within twelve months next after my decease **Item** I give unto my son **Richard Collens** one shilling & to be paid him within twelve month next after my decease.

**Item** All the rest & residue of my Goods & Chattels whatsoever I Give & bequeath unto my Loveing Sone **Robert Collens** (upon condicion that he shall pay all my debts & Legacies And make him full & Sole Executor of this my last will & testament. And I doe hereby revoke disannull & make void all former wills & testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof I the said **John Collens** have hereunto sett my hand & seale the three & twentyeth day of January Anno Dm 1698/
