This Will was proved at Marlborough the Sixteenth day of May 1743 before the Reverend Robert Clavering Clerk Master of Arts lawfull Surrogate of the Reverend and Worshipful Henry Stebbing Doctor in Divinity Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry of Wilts and by him Astration of the Effects of the Said Stephen Warren deceased was granted to Hannah Warren his Widow Relict and Sole Executrix within named Being First Sworne to the truth of the said Will to perfome the same and so forth and to Exhibit an Inventory and an Account when lawfully required and so forth

In the name of God Amen I Stephen Warren of Alborn in the County of Wilts Groser being butt weak in body butt in perfect mind and memory and becaus of the uncertainty of this Life doe make this my Last Will and Testament in maner and form Following. (that is to say) First and Chiefest of all I Committ my Soul to Allmity God who gave it me and my body to the Earth to be buried According to the descretion of my Exssecutors hearafter mention. And for my Estate and goods which it hath pleased God to bestow uppon I give and dispose of as following Imprimes I Will that all my Jest debts and funarall Expences be discharged. Item. I give to Hanah my wife all my Estate of free-hold and Coppie hold houses and Land during the Term of her natural life and after he deceas to my Kinsman Edward Warren my Brothers Son the free hold house and Land with all the appurtanance to him and his heirs and Assigns for euer and the Coppie hold for his Life and also Twenty pounds out of my personall Estate to becom payable within one year after my decease Item. I give to my Sister Warman the sixty pounds which she have of mine allready upon security Item. I give to my sister Margreat wife of Robert Wodam Fiftie Shilling a year during her Life to be paid by my Executor and after he decese to pay Fiftie pounds to her Children by Equal perposion and Robert Wodam their Father to no right to the anuaty or Legasies. Item. I give to my Kinswoman Mary Goldsmeth Thirty pounds to be paid within a year after my decese. Item. I give to my Kinsman Warren Looker Ten pounds to be paid when he shall Come to the age of one and Twenty. Item. I give to my Kinsman Thomas Pettis Ten pounds to be paid within a year after my decese. Item. I give to Anne the wife of Thomas Flory my Silber Tanket after my wifes decese Item I give to Sarah the daughter of Jacob Leadard five pounds to be paid when She Shall Come to the age of one and Twenty Item. And all the rest personall Estate of goods money bond and Bills Morgages and also housal goods and Shop:goods and Shep:debts and a;; which I now posess I give to Hanah my Louing wife making her my whole and Sole Excecutris uppon Condicon She Shall pay all my debts and Legasies as the Shall becomb dew. And I doe apoint my friend John Mugg in Trust to act with my wife and to See that all things be done acording to the trew intent and making void all other wills made by me other by word or writing I doe publish this to be my Last Will and Testament this fourteenh day of January 1741
