And doe mainetaine & iustifie the Inventarie now extend to be the true & perfect Inventarie of all the Decesseds goods cattells & creditts & thereupon doo yeald & render a true & iust accopmt at or before the feast of the annunciacon of our blessed lady the virgin next & such part & porcon of the residue of the same goods as shalbe found upon the said accompt exaied & allowed remaying unadministred shall distribute saisyf & pay in such manner & sort as by the above named m^r Archdeacon or his officiall or anie other competant Judge in this behalf shalbe lymitted and appointed. That then this obligacon to be voyd and of none effect or els to remayne in full power force and vertue./.
