In the name of God Amen The Fyftene daye of Januarie in the yeare of o' Lord God A thowsand Fyve hundred Nintie Nyne; I Richard Sparowe of Alborne in the Countie of Wilts being sicke of bodie but of good Remembrance thankes be to god, Doe make this my Last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge; First I bequeth my Soule to almighty God my maker Savio' and redeemer and my bodie to be buryed in the Church yarde of Alborne aforesaide; Inprimis I gyve to the poore of Alborne Tenne shillings, Item I gyve to my Cosen Richard Sparowe fortyeshillings; Item I gyve unto my Cozen Margarett Fortie Shillings, the Children of my Sonne John all the rest of my goods as well moveable as unmoveable as bonds or bills or anie debts are oweing me or else whatsoever that is due unto me; I doe make my sonne John my full and hole Executo'; Also I ordaine and make overseers to this my Last will and Testament, Thomas Fowler and Thomas Collence, My debts and Legacies being paide I gyve all my goods and Corne and Catell as is aboue written unto my sonne John, these being witness Thomas Fowler Thomas Collence with others
