Imprimis I will that my Debts and Funerall Charges shall be pa[id and] discharged

Item I give unto my Brother **John Paty** One Shilling <hole> also That Twenty Shillings which he took up of my Brother in Law **William Thomas** alias **Jenkins** by my order Item I give unto my sister **Jane Paty** One Shilling and alsoe the Five Shillings which shee borrowed of me

All the rest and residue of my Coppyhold Lands Personal Estate Goods and Chatles whatsoever I doe give and bequeath unto my loving Brother in Law William Thomas alias Jenkins full and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament And I doe hereby revoke disanul and make void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I the said Joseph Paty to this my Last Will and Testament have sett my hand and seal the Seaventeenth Day of April in the First year of the Reigne of our Soueraigne Lord and Lady William and Mary by the Grace of God of England France and Ireland King & Queen Defenders of the Faith &c Annogr Dom 1689./
