Item I do give devise and bequeath all & singular my Goods Chattells and effects of what nature kind or quality soever they are or be unto my loving Wife **Jane Gwin**

Item I do hereby Nominate constitute & appoint my said Wife full and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament

Lastly revoking disannulling and making void all former and other Wills and bequests heretofore by me made I do declare this to be my last Will and Testament
