Being sicke of bodie but of good and perfite memory – thanckes be to god doe make this my last and [sic] testament in maner and forme folowing fyrst I bequeth my soul to almyghtye god my maker and Saviour and Redeemer and my bodie to be buried in the church yeard of **alborne** aforesayd Item I give and bequeth to my daughter **Jane Hobs** ten poundes in monye which is in the handes of **Steeven Ballard membery** and my best Brass pot and my biggest Coffar ~~and my best Dublat and my best Braches~~ I give to my brother **henry hobs** my best coate and my best Dublet and my best Breches and five shillings in monye which is in the handes of **Steve Ballard** of **mynbery** all the Rest of my goodes amd chattels my Debtes and legacyes payd I give and bequeth to one **margreat hobs** my wif who I make my full and whol executrix also I Doe desire and ordayne M^r Roger Waldron to be overseer to this my last and [sic] testament these being wittnesses **thomas hide henry hobs** and **John young** wth others
