In the name of god amen: I **John Jat** of the parish of **Albourne** husbandman. beinge weake in body but
in perfect memory do make and ordaine this my ;ast will and testament, as followeth

Imprimis I bequeath my sould unto my sauour and redeemer trsutunge in him to haue the fruition of
everlastinge life;

Secondly I bequeath my body to the earth from whence it came of my worldly substance and goods,
Imp^rs I giue unto my sonne **John**, xxiiij of my best sheepe, and my best heiffer; my best brass pott: and
my best couerled my wearinge apparel a bed a paire of sheets and a bolster a swarme of bees; also I
giue unto him, my sonne **John**, my coffer, my best kettell, and best platter, and 4 loads of my best
woode to be brought unto him, at my executors charge; It[em] I giue unto my daughter **Elizabeth** xxiiij
sheepe my second best Couerled, and second brasse pott, and x pounds of woole, & a quart^r of barly a
bed and a paire of sheets and bolster; I giue unto my daughter **Precilla** xix sheepe and x pownds of
woole and a quarter of barly. It I giue unto my daughter **Annis** x pownds of woole and 3 sheepe, and
unto her 5 children 2 bushells of Barly a piece, and 3 pounds of woole apeice and to he selfe my sayd
daughter **Annis**, 4 bushells of barly. It[em] I giue unto my daughter **Joane** 3 sheepe and to her 2
children 2 bushells of barly a piece, and 3 pownd and halfe of woole apeice and to my sayd daughter
Jones daughter **Elizabeth** I giue 2 bushells of malte to be deliuered for their use within a mounth after
my decease the residue of my Corne, and woole ungiuen, and nt bequeathed I giue unto my sonns
William and **John**, equally to be divided betweene them; It I giue unto M^r **John Webb** and **Tho:**
Spansweeke j^s a piece;

All the rest of my goods and Cattell ungiuen, I bequeath unto my sonne **William** by debts legacies and
my funerall expences being discharged by my said sonne **William**, whome I make and apoynt to be my
sole executor of this my last will and testament I .. ordeine and institute to be the ouerseers and
superuisors of this M^r **John Webb** and **Thomas Spansweeke** desyringe them ... this my will to be
performed accordinge to the true meaninge ...ff//
