first I giue and bequeath to my sonne **Thomas Kinge** one keever as also halfe the corne that shall be found in the house and halfe the wood

Item I giue and bequeath to my grandchilde **John Kinge** one platter dish and tenn shillings of money to bee deliuered to hime when hee comes to discretion to vuse it

Item I giue and bequeath to **Jone Kinge** one platter dish and fiue shillings and a petticoat and a wastcoate and a greenn jackcoat and two quaiues and two handchacchers to be deliuered to her when shee comes to discreation to keepe it

Item and all the rest of my goods and chattels whatsoever not hearin menshoned I bequeath after my debts payd and my funerall expences discharged and this my will performed and fulfilled I doe giue and bequeath unto my daughter **Susann Kinge** whom I doe make and ordaine my wholl and solle Executrix of this my last will and Testament in witnes hearunto I the said **Elizabeth Kinge** widdow haue hearunto sett my hand and seall the day and yeare first aboue writern
