**Appeared** personally **Thomas Merriman** of **Marlbro** in the county of Wilts Gentleman and **Daniel Liddiard** of **Aldbourn** in the said county Yeoman and being sworn on the holy evangelists to depose the truth made oath that they knew & were well acquainted with **Nanny Moulding** formerly **Bunce** widow (wife of **William Moulding**) late of **Aldbourn** in the County of Wilts deceased for sometime before and up to the time of her death and also with her manner and character of hand writing and subscription having now carefully viewed and perused the paper writings hereunto annexed purporting to be and contain two testamentary schedules of the said deceased the first beginning thus "I give to my Niece **Mary** the Wife of **Levi Pizzie** of **Aldbourn** in the County of Wilts farmer" ending this "In witness whereof I have set my hand this fifteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and seventeen" and thus subscribed "*Nanny Moulding*" with the addition of "inquire of M<sup>r</sup> **W<sup>m</sup> Pike** of **Great Bedwin**" the second paper writing beginning thus "I give to my Niece **Ann** the Wife of **John Bunce** of **Aldbourn** in the county of Wilts Carpenter at my death" ending thus "In witness whereof I have set my hand this fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen" and thus subscribed "*Nanny Moulding*" with the addition of "Inquire of M<sup>r</sup> **W<sup>m</sup> Pike** of **Great Bedwin**" they severally say that they verily and in the conscience believe the body series of the and contents of the said paper writings with the subscriptions and additions thereto to be all of the proper hand writing & subscription of the said deceased *Tho Merriman, Daniel Liddiard*
